

HOW TO ACCESS STUDY ISLAND FOR OGT MATH PRACTICE

In order to prepare for the OGT fully, sometimes we need to practice even when we're not in school. Vermilion Local Schools offers Study Island as a practice tool for the different subjects (Math, Science, Social Studies, English), so that students can learn during their free time, practicing skills that will help them be successful on the OGT. The following are the steps to take in order to gain access into the website, and then where to go once logged in.

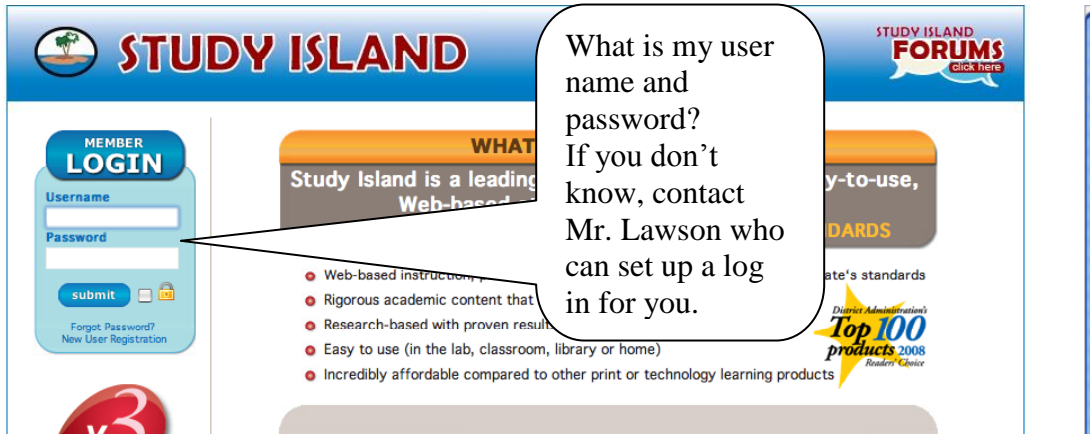
- 1) Log on to an internet browser, and go to www.vermilionschools.org. Click on "High School at the top of the page"
